Collects Mt. Pleasant Township & Fort Cherry School District Real Estate Taxes

Township taxes are mailed out each year on March 15<sup>th</sup>. Taxes can be paid at discount by May 15<sup>th</sup>, face until July 15<sup>th</sup> and are due at penalty after July 15<sup>th</sup>. Residents who live near street lights & hydrants are also assessed for these utilities. This assessment is added on to the township bill.

School taxes are mailed out each year on August 15<sup>th</sup>. Taxes can be paid at discount by Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>, face until Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>, and are due at penalty after Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>. School taxes can be paid in three equal installments. The school tax bills specify the amounts due for the installments, as well as the due dates.

The Fort Cherry School District also assesses a Per Capita Tax. This is a \$10 tax which is assessed on any resident, 18 years of age and over, who resides in the school district. This tax is added onto the real estate tax bill, or is billed separately for renters or dependents.

Unpaid township and school taxes are turned over to the Washington County Tax Claim Bureau by January 15<sup>th</sup> of the following year. Taxpayers must then make arrangements with the County for payment. Any unpaid light & hydrant assessments are turned over to an independent collection agency.

Payments may be mailed to the tax collector at 4 Kelley Lane, Hickory, PA 15340, or paid in person during scheduled office hours. All office hours are held at the Township Office located at 31 McCarrell Road, Hickory, PA. Preferred methods of payment are personal check or money order. Payments may also be dropped off during the week, during regular business hours, and will be held there for the tax collector. Payments dropped off must be in the form of check or money order. Cash cannot be accepted by anyone other than the appointed tax collector.

Mortgage companies, or closing agencies may request a three year tax certification by mailing their request to the tax collector. There is a \$15.00 charge for this service. The check should be made payable to Jamie L. Torboli. There is no charge for current tax information.
